

**20. MINISTRY FORMATION:**

The PVBI Christian Service Learning (CSL) program requires all students who are taking more than six semester hours to engage in Christian service and report their engagement to the director of the program. The Fall 2020 semester reports indicated that 91% (48 out of 53) of the students required to complete CSL achieved satisfactory progress in their Christian service requirements, and 94% of the full-time students completed CSL requirements. The program is an established part of education at PVBI.

InterServe (an organization run by Penn View under the direction of a staff person with a student leadership team) continues to provide opportunities in Christian Service. Most ministerial majors are scheduled to speak several times each semester. Students in vocational ministry programs are required to complete two six-week internships for credit, usually in the summer. Students in education programs are required to complete student teaching.
